

12 HOUR HOCKEY CHALLENGE FUNDRAISING CONTEST (the “Challenge”) Official Rules

ELIGIBILITY: The Challenge is open to legal U.S. residents, at least twenty one (21) years old at time of entry, who have registered for, and been approved and/or accepted by Sponsor to participate in, the 12 Hour Hockey Challenge event scheduled to take place on March 28, 2026 from approximately 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. Eastern Time (“ET”) at Stamford Twin Rinks in Stamford, CT (the “Event”). The Challenge is void outside this area and where prohibited by law. Directors, employees, and the immediate family (spouse, parent, sibling, children, grandparent or grandchildren and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) and/or household members of individuals, whether or not related, employed by MSG Sports, LLC (“MSG Sports”), MSG Entertainment Holdings, LLC, New York Rangers, LLC (“Rangers” and “Sponsor”), National Hockey League, its member teams and NHL Enterprises, L.P. (collectively, “NHL Entities”), Garden of Dreams Foundation (collectively, “Challenge Entities”), and all of their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, directors, officers, employees, advertising and promotional agencies, are ineligible to participate. The Challenge is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws.

REGISTRATION: If you wish to participate in the Event and the Challenge, visit <https://benefitgames.com/campaign/2026nyr12hourchallenge/> and follow the directions to complete and submit the registration form. Limit one (1) registration per person. Multiple registrations will be void. Registrations must be received by 11:59 p.m. ET on March 21, 2026. Multiple registrants are not permitted to share the same email address. All registrations become the sole property of Sponsor.

REGISTRANT VETTING AND NOTIFICATION: Submitting a registration form does not automatically permit you to participate in the Event or enter you into the Challenge. Sponsor reserves the right to review registrations as they are received and require the submission of additional information. The determination as to whether a registrant will be accepted to participate in the Event and enter into the Challenge shall be determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Sponsor will notify registrants via the email provided on the registration form as to whether they have been accepted to participate in the Event and entered into the Challenge. All registrants who have been accepted to participate in the Event (each, a “Participant”) will be placed by Sponsor into one of twelve (12) teams (each, a “Team”), which such Teams will be used by Sponsor for purposes of determining the “Top Fundraisers” for each Team Fundraising Award, as further detailed below. A Participant can only be on only one (1) Team. Team placements are solely in Sponsor’s discretion. All Participants will be required to sign a liability/publicity release on a form as provided by Sponsor prior to participating in the Event. If a Participant fails to sign and return such liability/publicity release or is otherwise not in compliance with these Official Rules, such Participant may be disqualified from, and forfeits the right to participate in, the Event and the Challenge, including any potential awards in connection therewith.

CHALLENGE PARTICIPATION: Between 10:00 a.m. ET on December, 11 2025 and 7:00 p.m. ET on March 27, 2026 (“Fundraising Period”), in connection with their participation in the Event, Participants and Teams will be expected to raise funds for the Garden of Dreams Foundation through the donation portal at <https://benefitgames.com/event/2026nyr12hour/> (“Donation Portal”) in accordance with any rules, policies and/or guidelines provided by Sponsor, including as provided on the Donation Portal. Participants will be asked to create an account within the Donation Portal and agree to the Donation Portal’s Terms of Use and Privacy Policy. Account creation is free. Funds raised outside of the Donation Portal and/or outside of the Fundraising Period will not be considered when determining the Top Fundraisers.

Participants acknowledge and agree that only a limited number of individuals may participate in the Event. As such, each Team must raise a minimum of \$20,000 in donations through the Donation Portal by 7:00 p.m. ET on March 27, 2026. If a Team fails to raise the required minimum donations by such time, Sponsor shall have the right to take any such action as it deems reasonable in its sole discretion, including, without limitation,

disqualifying such Team from participating in the Event and Challenge. Decisions of Sponsor with respect to any such actions are final and binding.

TOP FUNDRAISER DETERMINATION: Following the conclusion of the Fundraising Period, Top Fundraisers will be determined for the following categories:

Top Team Fundraisers: Of the Teams who raise at least \$30,000 in donations, the two (2) Teams who raised the highest amount in donations through the Donation Portal as of the conclusion of the Fundraising Period will be deemed the Top Team Fundraisers and receive the Top Team Fundraiser Award (as described below). In the event no Team raises at least \$30,000 in donations, this Award will not be provided. In the event only one (1) Team raises at least \$30,000, only one (1) Award will be provided.

Top Individual Fundraisers: The four (4) Participants who raise the highest amount in donations through the Donation Portal as of the conclusion of the Fundraising Period will be deemed Top Individual Fundraisers and receive a Top Individual Fundraiser Award. Actual Top Individual Fundraiser Award will be dependent on where they placed in the ranking of Top Individual Fundraisers. See Award section below for complete Award details.

In the event of a tie for any Award, the Team or Participant (as applicable) from among those tied with the highest number of individual donations will be deemed the applicable Award recipient(s). Decisions of Sponsor are final and binding.

All Awards are subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules. Note that the outcome of the Event has no impact on determining the Award recipients.

TOP FUNDRAISER NOTIFICATION AND REQUIREMENTS: Top Fundraisers (and if a Team, all Participants of the Team) will be notified via email on or about March 28, 2026 and may be required to sign and return an Affidavit (or Declaration) of Eligibility and Liability/Publicity Release within five (5) days of the date of notice to claim the Award. If an Award notification is returned as undelivered or a Top Fundraiser (and if a Team, all Participants of the Team) fails to sign and return all required documents within the required time period or is not in compliance with these Official Rules, they may be disqualified and will forfeit the Award. If any Participant for any Team fails to comply with the requirements herein, the entire Team may be disqualified in Sponsor's sole discretion. In the event of disqualification for any reason, Sponsor may Award the Award to a runner-up, time permitting.

AWARDS:

Top Team Fundraiser Award (2 available): An opportunity to play a fantasy hockey game at the Arena and passes to one (1) suite for up to twenty-one (21) individuals for a Rangers 2026-2027 regular season home game later that same day (all details, including suite location and game date to be determined by Sponsor). Approximate Retail Value ("ARV"): \$12,500. Only the Team Participants are eligible to play in the fantasy game, unless otherwise agreed by Sponsor. Substitutions will not be permitted. Exact details of the Award will be determined by Sponsor. All Team Participants will be required to sign a liability/publicity release on a form as provided by Sponsor prior to participating in the fantasy game. **TRAVEL TO/FROM THE ARENA IS NOT INCLUDED AS PART OF THE AWARD AND IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TEAM PARTICIPANTS.**

Top Individual Fundraiser Award – 1st (1 available): Two (2) Tickets to a Rangers 2025-2026 regular season home game at the Arena (all details, including seat locations and game date to be determined by Sponsor); the opportunity for winner and one guest to have a pre-game meal with a former Rangers player prior to the game (all details, including timing and location, to be determined by Sponsor); the opportunity for winner and one guest to take a post-game photograph on the ice following the Rangers game; and the opportunity for winner

and one guest to attend a Rangers practice (all details, including practice date and location to be determined by Sponsor) (ARV \$).

Top Individual Fundraiser Awards – 2nd, 3rd, 4th (3 available): One autographed Rangers jersey (specific player to be determined by Sponsor) (ARV: \$150).

Specific Award Conditions/Restrictions: Transportation to/from any of the experiences provided hereunder, including the applicable Rangers game, fantasy game and Rangers practice, is not included as part of the Award. Sponsor is not responsible if any part of the prize, including the fantasy game and/or applicable Rangers game, is delayed, postponed or cancelled for any reason. Tickets may be subject to Sponsor's standard rain-check policies and procedures. Award winners, as applicable, must be able and eligible to attend and/or participate in the applicable Rangers game(s), fantasy game or other prize element, or the applicable portion of the Award will be forfeited. Team Participants and any guests agree to abide by any terms, conditions and restrictions provided by any applicable tickets as well as all venue rules and regulations. Failure to do may result in forfeiture of Award. The former Rangers player participating in the pre-game meal will be determined by Sponsor and there are no guarantees of guests meeting any specific player. Post-game photo opportunity and Rangers practice experience does not include photos with the Rangers players, staff, coaches or the opposing team. Autographs and/or photographs with players, coaches, or staff will not be permitted at any time during the Award experiences, except as permitted by Sponsor in its sole discretion. The autographed item(s) is not game used and/or game worn and the actual ARV of the autographed item(s) may vary based on market fluctuation.

General Award Conditions/Restrictions: Awards are provided "as is" with no warranty or guarantee, either express or implied. Award recipients may not substitute, assign or transfer an Award or redeem an Award for cash, but Sponsor reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to substitute an Award (or portion thereof) with one of comparable or greater value. Award recipients are each responsible for all applicable federal, state and local taxes, if any, as well as all costs and expenses associated with Award acceptance and use not specified herein as being provided. All Award details are at Sponsor's sole discretion. Limit one (1) Top Individual Fundraiser Award per Participant.

PUBLICITY: Except where prohibited, participation in the Event and Challenge constitutes each Award Recipient's consent to Challenge Entities and their respective parent, subsidiary and affiliated companies and their respective designees to use his/her name, likeness, photograph, voice, opinions, biographical information, hometown and state for advertising and promotional purposes, in any manner, in any and all media, now or hereafter devised, worldwide in perpetuity, without further payment or consideration, notification or permission.

PRIVACY POLICY: The personal information collected/provided in connection with the Event and Challenge will be used in accordance with the Privacy Policy, which can be found at <https://www.msgsports.com/privacy/>. Entrants who provide their email address will automatically enrolled to receive emails from or on behalf of Sponsor or others and can opt out of receiving future emails at any time by following the directions provided in such emails.

GENERAL CONDITIONS: Released Parties are not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, inaccurate, stolen, delayed, misdirected, undelivered or garbled registrations, donations, emails, or other communications of any kind, or postage-due, damaged or illegible mail; or for lost, interrupted or unavailable network, server, Internet Service Provider (ISP), website, or other connections, availability or accessibility or miscommunications or failed computer, satellite, telephone or cable transmissions, lines, or technical failure or jumbled, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected transmissions or computer hardware or software malfunctions, failures or difficulties, or other errors or difficulties of any kind whether human, mechanical, electronic, computer, network, typographical, printing or otherwise relating to or in connection with the Event or Challenge, including, without limitations, errors or difficulties which may occur in connection with the administration of the Challenge, the Donation Portal, the processing or tabulation of donations, the announcement of the Awards, or in any Event-and/or Challenge-related materials. Released Parties are also not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate

information, whether caused by site users, tampering, hacking, or by any equipment or programming associated with or utilized in connection with the Event or the Challenge. Released Parties are not responsible for injury or damage to participants' or to any other person's computer or other device related to or resulting from participating in the Event or Challenge or downloading materials from or use of the Donation Portal. Sponsor reserves the right to cancel or modify the Challenge if fraud, technical failures or any other factor impairs the integrity of the Challenge, as determined by Sponsor in their sole discretion. In such event, Sponsor reserves the right to Award the Awards based on fundraising amounts received up to the time of the impairment or as otherwise deemed fair and appropriate by Sponsor. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual they find to be tampering with the operation of the Challenge or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules, or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to deliberately damage or undermine the legitimate operation of the Challenge is a violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such an attempt be made, Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages and other remedies (including attorneys' fees) from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. Sponsor's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. In the event of a dispute regarding registrations received from multiple users having the same e-mail account, the authorized subscriber of the e-mail account at the time of entry will be deemed the Participant and must comply with these Official Rules. Authorized account subscriber is the natural person who is assigned the e-mail address by the Internet Service Provider (ISP), on-line service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses.

RELEASE/LIMITS OF LIABILITY: By participating in the Event and/or Challenge, each Participant and Award recipient agrees to release and hold harmless the Challenge Entities and their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, officers, directors, shareholders, agents, employees and all others associated with the development and execution of the Event and Challenge (collectively, "Released Parties") from and against any losses, damages, rights, claim or cause of action of any kind arising, in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, out of participation in the Event or Challenge or resulting directly or indirectly, from acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of any Award provided in connection with the Event or Challenge (including any activity related thereto), including without limitation personal injury, death, and/or property damage, as well as claims based on publicity rights, defamation, and/or invasion of privacy.

DISPUTES: Each Participant agrees that: (i) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with the Event and/or Challenge, or any Awards Awarded, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the United States District Court for the District of New York or the appropriate New York State Court located in New York; (ii) any and all claims, judgments and Awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering the Event or Challenge and in no event will Participant be permitted to obtain attorneys' fees or other legal costs; and (iii) under no circumstances will Participants be permitted to obtain Awards for and Participants hereby waive all rights to claim punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased. **SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, SO THE ABOVE MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU.** All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of the Participant and Sponsor in connection with the Event or Challenge, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of New York, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules (whether of the State of New York or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of New York.
